Your Advocacy Matters

Budget

- County Elderly and Disabled Transportation Assistance Program (85.21) – 10% increase.
- Tribal Elderly Transportation Assistance Program (85.215) – 20% increase.
- Specialized Transportation Program, includes purchase of Human Service Vehicles, operating budgets, Mobility Managers, coordination and non-vehicle capital (85.22) – 20% increase.

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Budget

- Urban Mass Transit Operating Assistance (85.20) 4% increase.
- Paratransit Aids (85.205) – 20% increase.

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Budget

- Funding for DMV Customer Service Centers: sufficient funding to expand service hours and create more mobile service centers to reduce barriers nondrivers face in obtaining State ID for purposes of voting and other services requiring proof of identity.

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Budget

- Complete Streets: Restore roadway design considerations in state law that support non-motorist infrastructure known as Complete Streets, empowering local communities to safely integrate all modes of transportation.

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Budget

- Provide a tax credit of up to \$1500 annually for people with vision loss for employment related transportation services to get to and from work. Expenses include fares from mass transit, paratransit and ride-share services. Proposed by Beyond Vision.
