2024 is an Election Year. Know Your Voting Rights!

- Accessible voting machine in your polling place.
- Assistance from anyone you choose (except your employer, your union rep or a candidate) whether voting in person or absentee.
- Use of other accommodations such as magnifier, signature guide or chair.
- Assistance in returning your absentee ballot.
- Request a large print or braille ballot (though they may not be available in your municipality).

If you encounter barriers:

- Ask to speak with the Chief Elections Inspector at your polling place.
- If the issue is not resolved, call the Disability Rights Voter Hotline at 844-347-8683.
- Report your accessibility concerns to the Wisconsin Elections Commission at <https://elections.wi.gov/form/report-an-accessibility-concern>.
